Free work selection. **Deadline: 20.12.2019**

Twelve (12) guitarists will be accepted. Therefore the videos will only be evaluated if there are more than 12 applicants. Notifications by email will be sent by **5.1.2019**.

Second round: Three works or movements from different epochs, one of them a work of the new music of the 20th / 21st century (definition see: https://de.wikipedia.org/wiki/Neue_Musik). Total playing time 15-20 minutes. Audition date: Sat, 22.2.2020. The order will be decided by a draw (the draw will be on 21.2.2020, 6.30 pm at the welcome of the participants).
